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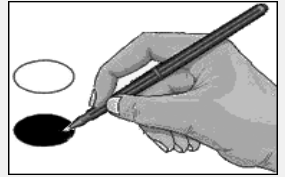

<p><i>SHALL</i> the order authorizing \$14,000,000 of bonds plus interest to provide funds to pay the capital costs of acquiring, constructing, expanding, renovating, equipping and furnishing public facilities to be used for municipal services, including town hall that incorporates community meeting space; police; firefighting; and other administrative services; and the acquisition of land, rights-of-way and easements therefor, and providing that additional taxes may be levied in an amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds be approved?</p> <p><input type="radio"/> Yes</p> <p><input type="radio"/> No</p>		<p>The sale of the communications system known as Continuum and related assets to TDS Broadband Service LLC on terms approved by the Boards of Commissioners of the Town of Mooresville and the Town of Davidson, including a total purchase price of \$80 million, subject to adjustments, escrows, and provisions obligating the Towns of Mooresville and Davidson to indemnify the buyer for certain losses caused by breaches of warranties and representations or excluded liabilities. The complete terms of sale are contained in an Asset Purchase Agreement which is and has been available for review at the Town Halls of Mooresville and Davidson and online at <www.townofdavidson.org> and <www.moorevillenc.gov>.
